Thaw turkey at a safe temperature - 40°F or below



U

Use extra caution when frying a turkey and oil-free fryers if possible



R

Remember to clean all cooking surfaces regularly



K

Keep children away from hot foods and surfaces, and kitchen utensils



E

Ensure turkey is cooked and has reached minimum temperature of 165°F



Y

Your smoke detector should be tested prior to cooking

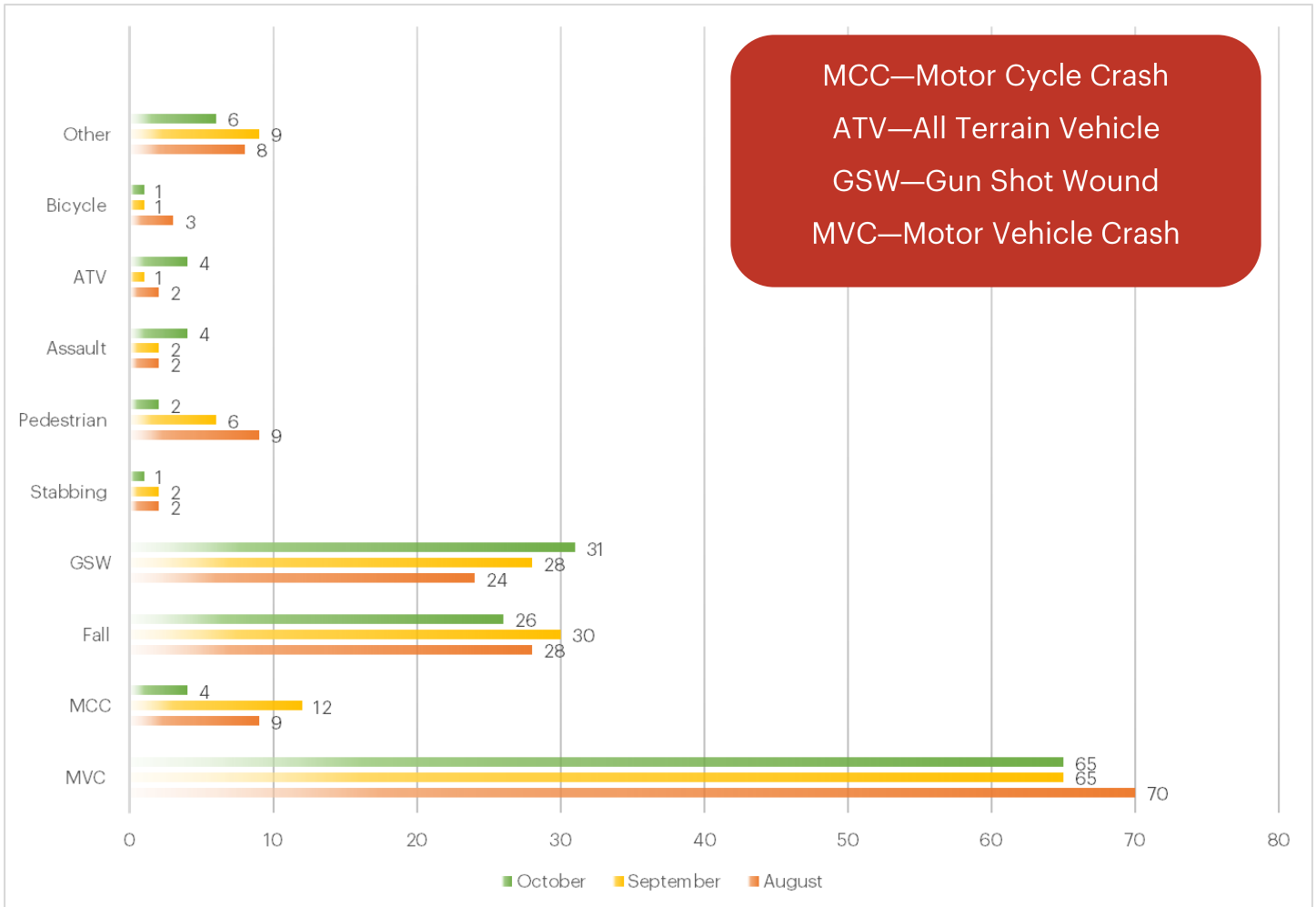

THE GREATEST NUMBER OF HOME-COOKING FIRES OCCUR ON THANKSGIVING.

TOP CAUSES OF HOME FIRES:

- HEAT SOURCE TOO CLOSE TO FLAMMABLE MATERIALS
- PRODUCT MISUSE (MOSTLY TURKEY FRYERS)
- UNATTENDED EQUIPMENT
- ACCIDENTALLY LEAVING COOKING EQUIPMENT ON
- ABANDONED MATERIAL
